

Across the plateau, herders have an annual income of 1200 RMB **(US\$177).** They live on subsistence farming with limited cash income

Shokay's Value Chain

1.Herders

SHOKAY buys yak down directly from Tibetan herders in the Qinghai region.



2. Combers& Spinners

Raw yak fiber is outsourced to combers and spinners in other parts of China to clean, dye, and spin hair into fine yarns.



3. Knitters & Weavers

Yarns are sent to our hand knitting base in Chong ming or other factories (for machine knit/ woven items) to produce into finished products.



4. Distributors Wholesalers

Shokay sells the finished products directly thorugh its own channels, but also through distributors and wholesalers to sell products all over the world.












Shokay seek to empower Yak communities through income generation and social programming





































YAK

Fabric made from yak down has more lustre than wool, handles well and provides excellent heat insulation. Down fibre diameter: 15-22 microns



Properties of Yak Fiber

Yak down is a luxury fiber that is relatively unknown to the fashion world.

International fiber experts claim that yak down rivals the softness of cashmere, alpaca, and qiviut (source: Time Magazine, April 2007).

Each yak produces about 100g of fine downy fiber. The average fineness of down from an adult yak is 18-20 microns, while the length is around 30-40 mm. Yaks that live in higher altitudes have finer fiber. The most common natural color of the yak is a dark chocolate brown, but can also be found in white, tan, and grey. Unlike wool, the scales of yak fiber are in a waved mosaic pattern, resulting in a very smooth fiber that does not itch.







Our Communities



Challenge:

In the Hei Ma He Township in Qinghai Province, families struggle to survive with an annual per capita income of only RMB 1200 and limited access to decent education, infrastructure, and healthcare. They live in very basic conditions due to lack of market access

Resource:

Each family has on average 30-40 yaks



Chongming Island, located next to Shanghai, is China's third largest island. It is largely agricultural. Most of Chongming's working population actually resides in Shanghai, where there are more job opportunities

Knitting provides women in rural areas the opportunity to earn additional income with flexible work hours so they can still attend to their household responsibilities


